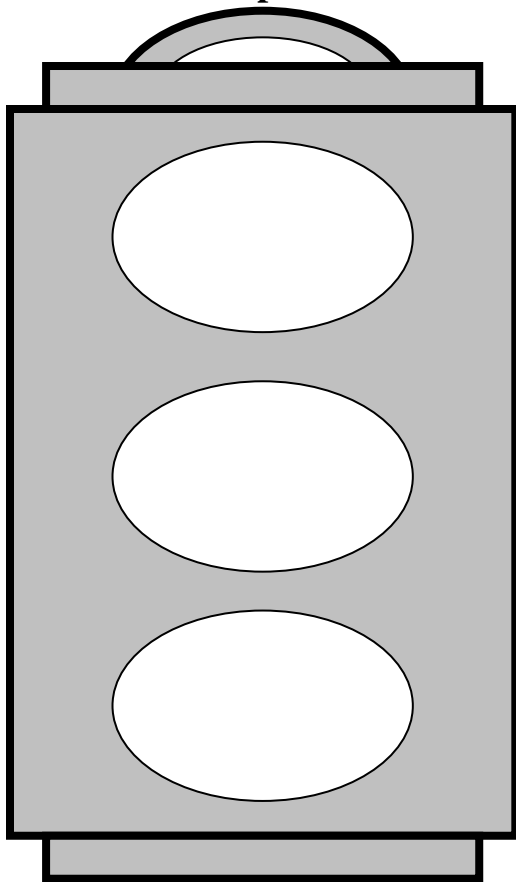

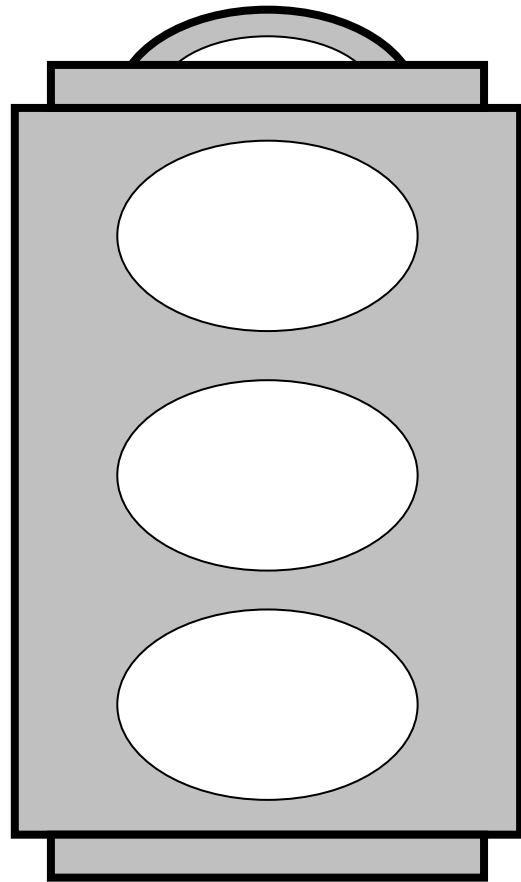
Signs to Stop and Go

Directions: 1) Color the circles as directed. 2) Cut out each traffic light. 3) Glue one on each side of a Popsicle stick, back to back.

Color the top circle **RED**



Color the bottom circle **GREEN**



When your teacher reads these statements, show either the Red or Green light. Remember, **Green** means “Good” or “Go” and **Red** means “Bad” or “Stop.”
